If your dog is under the age of 2 or over the age of 7, it is recommended you check with your veterinarian before the first class to ensure your dog is physically ready for agility.

Beginning Agility:

Admission Requirements: Dog must be able to demonstrate a Novice II level of obedience. This requirement may be achieved by passing the TDTC Novice Obedience-II class evaluation, or by earning either an AKC or UKC Novice obedience leg.

Note: ALL handlers who have been training at TDTC, entering Beginning Agility for the first time must submit the attached "Beginning Agility Supplemental Enrollment Form". Handlers/dogs not training before at TDTC previously or have not trained in over a year, must contact the Agility Director to discuss their training history and possibly schedule an evaluation of their dog's obedience skills and behavior.

Advanced Beginning Agility:

Admission Requirements: Dog must be able to demonstrate a knowledge of Novice Obedience and Beginning Agility. This requirement may be achieved by passing the TDTC Beginning class evaluation.

Note: Handlers/dogs not training before at TDTC previously, must contact the Agility Director to discuss their training history and possibly schedule an evaluation of their dog's obedience skills and behavior. Advanced Beginner Agility handlers are encouraged to continue in an obedience class.

Novice Agility:

Admission Requirements: All requirements for Beginning Agility or Advanced Beginning must be met. Dog must be able to demonstrate basic knowledge and acceptance of agility obstacles. The handler must be able to demonstrate control of his/her dog while running an agility course. This requirement may be achieved by passing the TDTC Beginning Agility class evaluation (Note: Testing only offered on normal class test day), or by earning a UKC qualifying score towards a Beginners and Intermediate agility title or one leg AKC Novice Agility (NA). Registration for class officially opens at the conclusion of testing for the previous Novice Agility class. The following priorities will apply when accepting registrations:

- 1) TDTC instructors with a dog qualifying for this level.
- 2) Students completing the previous Novice class but NOT recommended for advancement to Advanced Skills Agility.
- 3) Students advancing from the previous Beginners class; Students unable to proceed on to Advanced Agility due to class capacity; and students rejected from the previous class due to class capacity.
- 4) All other eligible registrants on a first-come basis.

Advanced Skills Agility:

Admission Requirements: Dog and Handler must be able to demonstrate Novice skill level on an agility course. This requirement may be achieved by passing the TDTC Novice Agility class evaluation (Note: Testing only offered on normal class test day), or by earning a UKC Beginners and Intermediate title, or by earning an AKC Novice Agility (NA) title. Registration for class officially opens at the conclusion of testing for Agility classes. The following priorities will apply when accepting registrations:

- 1) TDTC instructors with a dog qualifying for this level.
- 2) Students repeating Advanced Skills Agility
- 3) TDTC members and their dog(s) qualifying for this course.
- 4) All other eligible registrants on a first-come basis.

Note: For all classes, enrollments received in person at the agility tests will be processed first, followed by registrations received by mail or left in the Agility Mail Slot at TDTC.

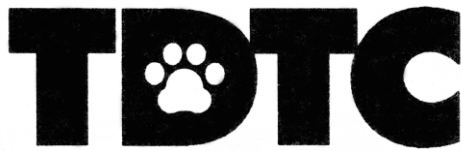
