HOTEL ETIQUETTE

Here are a few things you can do to increase privileges rather than restrictions on dog owners:

- Tell the hotel ahead of time of arrival that you have a dog and how big it is. Make sure you let them know it is an obedience-trained dog.
- Tip the housekeeper the first night. Leave her a note thanking her for a nice room.
- Don't groom or bathe your dog in your room.
- Carry your own Simple Solution or such to clean up any accidents and don't use hotel towels. Travel with your own paper towels.
- If you must leave your dog in the hotel, leave him/her crated. Leave your cell phone number or a number where you can be reached at the front desk while you're out.
- Control barking. If your dog barks when you're gone, then don't leave him/her alone. Call out for your dinner instead.
- Take a sheet from home and put it over bedspread if your dog is on the bed.
- Don't let your dog urinate on the bushes and plantings. Go to an area that is not landscaped if possible where it won't kill the plants.
- Pick up after your dog (and anyone else's) outside and deposit in an OUTSIDE TRASH RECEPTACLE.
- If your dog damages something, tell the management up front and pay for your dog's actions.

It only takes ONE uncaring person to lock all of us out of a hotel. Show them that obedience people care about not only their dogs, but for others and their property as well.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- I. The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
- II. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have proper vaccinations.
- III. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring.
- IV. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Tulsa Dog Training Club, Inc. or any official thereof.
- V. Puppies under the age of 4 months are prohibited from the show grounds according to AKC regulations.
- VI. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Tulsa Dog Training Club, the Trial Secretary, and stewards have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public-address system for the purposes of calling or finding dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis before a class begins.
- VII. No smoking inside the building.
- VIII. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities, building, and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- IX. The Tulsa Dog Training Club, Inc., and their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injuries sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- X. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; **illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. IF THE ENTRY FORM IS PHOTOCOPIED, THE AGREEMENT ON THE BACK OF THE FORM MUST ALSO BE PHOTOCOPIED AND ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY WHEN IT IS MAILED. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted as well as entries which specify any conditions as to their acceptance.** Changes, Additions, or Corrections to entry forms MUST be received in writing prior to the closing of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.
- XI. No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. No refund will be issued for any overpayment of \$10 or less. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- XII. Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$12.00 service charge attached. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- XIII. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, Veterinarian or Judge.
- XIV. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or complete by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

- XV. Bitches in season are not allowed in the trial. After closing, TDTC will refund 75% of the entry fees with a vet's certificate. This policy also applies to dogs injured after closing, The Trial Secretary must receive the written notification no later than 6:00 PM the day prior to the first day of trials. Refunds will be mailed within 10 working days. After closing, refunds will NOT be given for any other reason.
- XVI. The Tulsa Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against TDTC or any official thereof.
- XVII. Any exhibitor arguing with show officials, exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior violating AKC rules will be subject to Event Committee Jurisdiction.
- XVIII. If using a wire crate, please bring a mat, blanket, or other suitable item to place under the crate to protect our floors.
- XIX. Due to space limitations, no x-pens will be allowed.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
