#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

**Pre-Entry:** \$20.00 for the first run, \$10 each additional run of the same dog. Four (4) runs for \$40. Eight (8) runs for \$75. Includes \$5.00 AKC recording fee per run.

**Day of Show/Late entry:** \$25.00 for first run, \$15 each additional run of same dog, 4 rounds for \$60.00. Eight (8) runs for \$100.

# **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This event is <u>open to all dogs</u> fifteen (15) months of age and older provided they have not earned any AKC Agility Titles. Bitches in season are not eligible to enter and cannot be on-site. Dog must be physically sound as described in Chapter 1, Section 3, and Paragraph 7 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. In order to acquire the title certificate and the title added to the dog's record the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC. Canine Partner applications may be accepted at the test by the judge/evaluator and submitted with test results. Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary recording number will be e-mailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers/lists the dog. **NOTE:** Temporary recording numbers may only be used to enter ACT events. Entries must be made on Official AKC Agility Course Test Entry Form, must include the AKC agreement, be completed fully, signed, and legible.

ACT1/ACT1J are entry level tests that are open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). Dogs must have two passing ACT1 scores in order to earn the ACT1 title. For ACT1J dogs must have two passing ACT1J scores to earn the ACT1J title. To receive the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC.

ACT2/ACT2J are the second level Agility Course Tests that are open to all dogs that have dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3). Dogs must have two passing ACT2 scores in order to earn the ACT2 title. For ACT2J dogs must have two passing ACT2J scores to earn the ACT2J title. To receive the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC.

By entering this event you acknowledge that you are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

#### **OBSTACLES & TIMING:**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. This trial will be held indoors (climate controlled with rubberize mats and equipment and ring dimensions of approx. 50'x100'. Timing will be done with an electronic system.

ACT 1 is 10-12 obstacles and consists of the a-frame, pause table, open tunnel(s), bar jumps, and MAY also use the panel jump, and/or tire jump.

ACT 2 is 11-13 obstacles and consists of the a-frame, teeter, pause table, weave poles (6), open tunnel(s), tire jump, bar jumps, and double bar jump, panel jump, broad jump, and/or triple bar jump.

ACTJ (jumpers) 1 is 10-12 obstacles and consists of the one bar jumps, and MAY also use the open tunnel (max 3), bar jump, panel jump, tire jump.

ACTJ (jumpers) 2 is 11-13 obstacles and consists of weave poles (6) and a one bar jump, and MAY also use open tunnels (max of 3), bar jumps, double bar jump, panel jump, tire jump, broad jump, triple bar jump.

#### **RUNNING ORDER:**

For the ACT Program dogs may participate at **any** jump height which is determined by the owner.

Round 1 Small to Tall: 4", 8", 12", 16", 20", 24" Round 2 Tall to Small: 24", 20", 16", 12", 8", 4"

# **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION: SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, themselves, and/or their children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the test committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

I (we) acknowledge that if this application for the entry of this dog is made available to me (us) for participation in this event, that I (we) agree that this facility/club has the right to refuse the entry of this dog and/or they reserve the right to dismiss the dog and myself for cause which the facility/club deems to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this and the opportunity to train my dog(s), I (we) agree to hold American Kennel Club, Tulsa Dog Training Club, the facility, and all associates harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog or dogs while in or upon the premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for damage or injury to the dog or myself, either physically or mentally, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by negligence while in or upon the premises of the trial grounds. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including, and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

### **CRATING:**

Crating space is limited. If using a wire crate, a mat will be needed underneath to protect the rubber matting.

#### **VOLUNTEER:**

The best way to learn about agility is not just to be an exhibitor but to be a participant by learning to bar set, time, scribe, run leashes, gate steward, or course build.

#### **RINGSIDE:**

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Evaluator is not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. No refunds will be issued for absent or late dogs.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1, ACT2, ACTJ 1, or ACTJ2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine Partners** applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>sM</sup>** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
